March 30, 2025 – the deadline for notifying the organizers of your intention to participate in the conference in person (on-site)

April 10, 2025 – deadline for submitting the registration form with abstract and conference fee

June 30, 2025 – deadline for submitting a post-conference article to be published in „Security Dimensions”

Papers can be presented in Polish or English. Speakers are kindly asked to prepare short multimedia presentations in English – this is a mandatory requirement.

The deadline for submitting applications with abstracts is **April 10, 2025**.

In order to participate in the conference, you must submit a completed registration form and pay the conference fee by April 10, 2025.

In connection with the planned post-conference publication of the magazine, a structured abstract of the presentation in English (100-200 words) is a prerequisite for participation and receipt of a certificate containing the title of the presentation.

“Security Dimensions” (ISSN 2353–7000) has been published since 2007. It is an international peer-reviewed journal published in open access. Our quarterly journal has been awarded 40 points on the Ministry of Science and Higher Education list and is also indexed in databases such as ERIH PLUS, NSD, Publication Forum, CEJSH, CEEOL and ICV (with a maximum of 100 points in the last two years).
